THEY SCAN YOUR DRIVERS LICENSE AND PROCESS THERE. WE HAVE TO HAVE LICENSED PEOPLE ON ALL SHIFTS, OPEN UNTIL CLOSE. YOU SHOULD APPLY IN JULY so it is approved by Aug.

Without food & bar licensure we are closed. The club pays the fee. If you will license yourself in food, please go to Manitowoc.org & follow the prompts to food safety. You will need it for other organizations as well. We have to have licensed people in the food area. There is basic information with a basic test you can read and follow along with. If you would like to help cook, we still need a licensed person. We usually struggle for cooks. It is no different then grilling at home. You just can't be sure how many will come to your picnic so to speak. It actually doesn't matter. When an order comes, you make it. It's "Fairly" simple. Please consider pairing up with someone experienced for food. Doris & I will match you up.

Last season we registered 122 club members. There are 144 lines on the schedule. You are expected to help on a shift some where. The fair fills the groomer fuel tank and signs the trails.
